The name of our school is The Kosala School which is affiliated to CBSE and the affiliation number is 1530003. It is located in a rural area of Bargarh district, Odisha. Within 20kms of radius the students come to school regularly as a dayscholar and hosteler also. Even hundreds of students are from the out of the state, from Chhatishgarh, Jharkhand and Andhra Pradesh. The school was established long back in 1979 by few pragmatist farmers with a lofty aim to provide education to the students who cannot afford heavy academic expenditure in rich schools. This is a school for the small and marginal farmers. This is a service institute not a profit making organization. The school has got permanent Income Tax Exemption from the Chief Commissioner of the Income Tax, Bhubaneswar vide order bearing memo no. 22849-03 dated, Bhubaneswar, the 12th/16th March 2009. Further, The Kosala School has been declared as a Charitable Trust under Section 12A of Income Tax Act 1961 by the Commissioner of Income Tax, Sambalpur vide his order bearing memo no- 2226-31, dated 25th September 2009.
